Sustainability @ CIPL

Sustainability activities is incredibly important to us. However, it can be really tricky to know where to start. First, we need to help understand what sustainability is. Sustainability basically boils down to understanding the impact that we have on the earth, and what we leave for future generations.

We know that sustainability can encompass a



number of things, from recycling to gardening, and in being resourceful with products and items that we use. Here we are explaining some activities about sustainability that we are doing at

Jaipur head office building "CIPLAmbitions":

1. Plantation: During CSR program our team participated in plantation work on connecting road of office building.

2. Water Management:

a. Rain Water Harvesting: In our building, we have a provision of 100KL rain water storage tank and we have collected approx. 70 KL rain water in last rainy season. Our building total water requirement is 200 KL and we fulfilled our 35% water requirement in a year by rain water.

This year we are expecting good rainy season so that we can store approx. 95 KL Rain water that will fulfil approx.50% water requirement.

- b. Sewerage Treatment Plant: From STP, we are treating 5 KL waterdaily. This treated water is using for flushing. In this manner, 2.5% of total water requirement is fulfilled by STP.
- c. Use Waterless Urinals: The average urinal uses approx. 3.5 liters of water for each flush. A single urinal

can use approx. 25 KL water each year. (That estimate is based on a building with a few dozen male employees each using the urinal three times a day.) Whereas, waterless urinals save a 42% of flushing

water. They really do operate without water. The only water needed is a small amount roughly 1 liter used to flush the drain line as part of regular maintenance.

3. Photovoltaic solar power generation: Our building's total electricity consumption in a year (June, 18 to May, 19) is 48,000 Units. In which, 24,000 Units we have generated from our 25kW roof top photovoltaic solar system. This is a great effort that we are generating 50% of total consumption from solar.

Now, HO team is trying to reduce power consumption e.g. improve habit to switch off electrical appliances when not in use, keep AC temperature at 25°C etc. So that we can achieve the target to generate 75% of total consumption by solar.

4. Make A Mini Greenhouse: We have developed a roof top kitchen garden where we cropped coriander, mint, tomato, bottle guard etc.

Along with this our o f fi c e premises has surrounded from various plants. This will help to reduce atmospheric temperature.



Now, we are moving a step ahead and about to start waste management by recycling food waste, proper uses of papers and their proper dispose-off etc. So, team "GO ON A GREEN WALK" and preserve our natural resources for future generations.



- 5. 1010 KVA DG Set Work (RCDF)- This work order has been received from RCDF Ajmer. This is the work of 1010 KVA DG set supply and foundation work is in progress, cost of project is 78 lakhs. The team is involved in this task - Mr. Chetan Dhadhich, Mr. Prashant Kumar.
- 6. HT Work In PHED Project (OIL) This work order has been received from Offshore Infrastructure Ltd. Cost of this project is 1.75 Cr. It is going to be executed in Parbatsar. Said project is headed by Mr. Dinesh Mathur and their exection team members are Mr. Prashant Kumar, Mr. Ashutosh Sharma.

GUJARAT

- 1. Dwarka-Probandar Project (GRIL) CIPL team has completed 95% of electrical utility shifting from GRIL to Dwarka to Porbandar upto four lane. The total cost of this project is 15.80 Cr.. By January 31, 2019, the team has worked 13 crores. In this work, there is a work of about 64 KM road on the Four Lane road. out of which 122 crossings and 95 km is the common line. Our team has faced many difficulties in the work due to coastal and rocky areas, our team has almost completed in 6 months. The rest of the work is due to public issues. 
